Post Graduate (3:1)

1st Waldens Taramount Wot Dream May Come

Buff Dog of just 6 months, still raw and needing to mature, pleasing head with enough work for his age. Soft expression and good finish to foreface. Clean through the neck and shoulder and good forearm. Ribs starting to spring and plenty of length to loin. Topline needs to settle but plenty of time for this. Moved freely Best Puppy.

2nd Waldens Taramount Bicentennial Man

Open (3:1)

1st Dummett's Arrowbien New York City Boy at Almondsbury

Red & White dog with masculine head, good amount of work, soft expression. Clean though the neck and shoulders, depth to forechest and ribs sprung and well back, would prefer a little less length through the loin but he maintained his topline on the move. Moved well on an open side gait. Best of Breed

2nd Waldens Fieldgar Majestic Legend ShCM

Clumber Spaniel

Special Yearling (1)

Boden's Suelynda Chantilly

8 months bitch of good shape and size, feminine in head and expression with the correct amount of work for her age. Powerful through the neck with well placed shoulders, well bodied and good width to her quarters. If she continues in this way with her talented young handler I'm sure she has a bright future ahead.

Open (1)

Boden's Suelynda Heaven Sent

2 year old bitch with a lovely head piece, feminine and of the correct proportions and a kind eye. Good through the neck and shoulder with required return of forearm, depth to the chest and ribs sprung and well back to a correctly proportioned loin. Powerful quarters that she used to advantage on the move. In super coat and condition she covered the ground with ease and style. Best of Breed.

Irish Water Spaniel

Perera's Goldenacre Island Duchess of Brighstone

17mths bitch of good size and proportions. Feminine head and expression, strong neck and well placed shoulders, good depth to forechest, with well sprung ribbing and firm loin, quarters developing nicely and short from hock to heal. Moved on a free ground covering action, coat of decent curl and texture. Best of Breed

Spanish Water Dog

1st Eggingtons Valentisimo's Castro

A young dog I have judged before and done well, he has the correct proportions and balance, being oblong in outline and having the correct amount of substance. Well balanced masculine head, strong neck and well put together. A dog I really like but today was not settled at all with his new handler and just did enough to win the class.

German Shorthaired Pointer

Special Yearling (1)

1st Smith's Indijazz Young Love at Abbeyaire

10 months and so full of promise at this stage, she is well proportioned and balanced, everything in the right place. Feminine in head and expression with a good finish to foreface. Clean through the neck and shoulders, well balanced angulation both fore and aft, super topline that never faltered. Bodying up well and standing on super legs and feet. True accurate footfall and covered the ground well. Best of Breed

Limit (3:1)

1st Cotton's Barleyarch Florin

Bitch of good balance and proportions, feminine head and expression, little heavy and stuffy in neck today as carrying a little too much weight. Balanced angles fore and aft and correct amount of depth and bone. Standing on good legs and feet, she moved ok, true, but just did enough.

2nd Arkley's Indijazz Show Girl

Open (6:2)

1st Cook & Lambs Adhemar Break of Day ShCM

This boy certainly defies his years at 10, he moved like a trooper, sound and free covering the ground with ease. Masculine throughout without being overdone, good head and expression, straight front, well bodied and good quarters, standing on good legs and feet Reserve Best of Breed.

German Wirehaired Pointer

Open (2)

1st Cook & Lamb's Adhemar Dundreggan Over Milcook

Upstanding dog who for my taste is a little tall, however he was in such hard condition and moved covering the ground that this did not detract. Masculine in head and expression with good fringing, strong neck and clean over the shoulders, Ribs well sprung and firm through the compact loin. Quarters well developed and used to advantage on the move, his side gait was free and effortless. Standing on good legs and feet and harsh dense jacket. Best of Breed.

2nd Field & Burgess's Adhemar Dalmary

Hungarian Vizsla

Post Graduate (1)

Jones & Wilson's Ismeya Saint Beatrix

10 month old bitch puppy that looked a picture today, so well balanced and put together. Lovely head and expression for her age, super through the neck and shoulders with the desired return of forearm. Body developing nicely and ribs back to a well proportioned loin. Good rear angulation and well-muscled, needs to firm in topline and tighten a little in front but she has plenty of time for this. Hope she continues to develop in this way Best of Breed.

Open (1)

Jones & Wilson's Vizellven Ocean Zanta

Upstanding bitch who I see is mother to the puppy. Head feminine but a little plain, good neck and shoulder placement, good through the rib, short loin and developed quarters, enough bone but nails need attention. Moved covering the ground but a little loose in front action.

Hungarian Wirehaired Vizsla

Special Yearling (1)

Marsh's Morehay Faustine

9 months old bitch who is still rather raw, feminine in head and expression with fringing beginning to come. Good reach of neck, decent shoulder placement, ribs beginning to spring. Needs to body and strengthen throughout and coat needs to come.

Open (2)

1st Reeds Sh Ch Cuffnells Sweet Violet

Presents a clean outline of good shape and size, head a shade strong but still feminine and a gentle expression. Good through the neck and shoulders with adequate return of forearm and good depth to the chest. Ribs sprung and well back to a firm loin and powerful rear. Topline held throughout and moved out freely covering the ground well, in good coat and furnishings. Best of Breed.

2nd Dodds Cuffnells Forrester - RBOB

Curly Coated Retriever

Post Graduate (4:1)

Mahon's Curlabulls One and Only

Black bitch of lovely proportions and balance, correct wedge shaped head with feminine expression. Strong neck which led neatly into shoulders, good front angulation and depth to forechest, ribs springing well and back to a firm loin and holding her topline throughout. Quarters well developed with a moderate bend of stifle. Stands on good legs and feet, she moved freely and covered the ground with an accurate footfall, coat of crisp curls finishing the picture off well. Best of Breed

2nd Mistlin Maycourt Starman by Crookwood

3rd Miller & Millichamp's Elkysar Quaritch

Open (2)

1st Mahon's Curlabull New York Jet

14 month old male with masculine head and expression without being overdone. Strong through the neck with well placed shoulders, good depth to the chest and ribs springing nicely, firm through the loin and quarters developing well. Still needs to fully mature and body up but has everything in the right place so this is just a matter of time. Coat of correct texture and curl, he moved out well and covered the ground with ease.

2nd Miller & Millichamp's Curlabull Iron Lion Zion

Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retriever

Post Graduate (2:1)

Howell's Tollerice Bergeron

It was quite obvious that both dog and handler were new to this and although the performance was not spot on, I could easily see the qualities and assess the exhibit with ease. Such a great character, full of fun and attentive to his handler. 20 months and maturing well, lovely head and expression, with a hint of mischief in his eye. Strong neck of correct length and fitting neatly into well placed shoulders and required return of upper arm. Bodying up well, ribs sprung and firm through the loin which meant that he held his topline throughout. Quarters well developed and used to advantage.

On the move he went freely on a loose lead, true in action and covered the ground with ease. Super coat and condition and carried his tail well and wagging all the way. Best of Breed

Limit (1)

1st Andrews Erikachen For Aftonmarsh

Masculine head and kind expression, well placed ears used to advantage, strong through the neck and shoulders well placed, good angles fore and aft and ribs back to a firm loin. Good depth, would just like a little more length of leg to complete the picture. Moved true and covered the ground well.
